As far as manmade sites, few are more striking than the soaring California Lighthouse. Aruba's oldest lighthouse, the beacon is named to honour a ship that sank here in 1891, before the island constructed its first lighthouse. Continuing on, the terrain will become much more arid, an ideal landscape for cacti, Aruba's signature divi-divi trees, iguanas and wild goats. The jumble of massive boulders known as the Casibari Rock formations rise out of this desert-like environment and are well worth closer inspection. Ostriches also thrive here, as you will discover at a farm that breeds these flightless birds, which are the world's largest. Finally, you will pause for photos of the Baby Natural Bridge, a coral rock formation that spanned a finger of the sea until it collapsed in 2005	This tour involves limited walking, mainly at the guests' discretion. After sailing along the island's western shore, you will stop at Boca Catalina, a sugar-white beach with a spectacular reef not far from shore. It is an excellent spot for snorkelling, as the water is typically crystal-clear and only about 15 feet deep. You can expect to observe a variety of colourful tropical fish, including blue parrotfish, which usually gather here in huge numbers. You will next snorkel the wreck of the Antilla, a German ship that was scuttled here shortly after Germany invaded the Netherlands in 1940. The 400-foot ship is lying on its side and over the decades has become a spectacular artificial reef teeming with marine life. After settling into the vessel, which is one of a fleet of the world's largest passenger submarines, you will begin the descent in air-conditioned comfort. The deeper the submarine ventures, the more marine life you can expect to view through the large porthole windows. Chances are, you will observe brilliant blue parrotfish, a striped species of damselfish known as sergeant majors and graceful sea turtles. You might also catch sight of several manmade objects that have become artificial reefs such as a sunken airplane and the remains of a shipwreck. The submarine presents you with views rarely seen except by deep diving.	This tour includes limited walking. It is not available to wheelchair guests and those with mobility concerns should evaluate their personal level of stamina and ability before joining the tour, as participants must be able to make their own way into and out of the ferry vessel. There is also an 11-step steep ladder to negotiate to enter and exit the submarine. To experience colour changes at various depths, guests may choose to wear clothes with red or fluorescent colours. The minimum height requirement to participate in the tour is 36 inches and children must be at least 4 years of age and accompanied by an adult parent or guardian. You will first set off for The Butterfly Farm, a tropical garden teeming with colourful butterflies. Besides viewing the beautiful creatures as they flit about, you will learn all sorts of fascinating facts about butterflies, including how they use camouflage to protect themselves from predators. Continuing on, you will pass some of the island's iconic divi-divi trees, which act as natural compasses, as the constant trade winds force them to grow southwest. Later, you will visit the Aruba Aloe Museum and Factory and discover how the succulent aloe has been grown on the island since 1890 and is now processed for cosmetics. You will enjoy uninterrupted views of the gorgeous countryside as you travel through Aruba's rugged interior, often on roads only accessible in a 4-wheel-drive vehicle. The seaside pool lies within the Arikok National Park, an environmentally protected wonderland that covers nearly 20% of the island. It will be immensely relaxing to ease into the crystal-clear waters of the secluded pool, which fills a bowl-like depression in the volcanically formed shoreline. Nearby, you will explore Fontein Cave, whose limestone walls are covered with reddish-brown drawings – some floor-to-ceiling – that the indigenous Arawaks created long ago. Anthropologists speculate that the artists may have been under the influence of psychedelics. To experience a weird sensation yourself, dip your feet into the freshwater pool nearby and enjoy a fish pedicure of sorts. The catamaran is renowned for its speed and spaciousness so feel free to move around the deck, sit in the shaded cockpit and relax in the netting between the hulls. One of the highlights will be snorkelling the wreck of the Antilla, a German ship that was scuttled off Boca Catalina Beach in 1940. The 400-foot ship is lying on its side and over the decades has become an artificial reef teeming with marine life. Sea turtles are also plentiful, especially at nearby Tres Trapi, where you will have the opportunity to swim with these graceful creatures. A hearty meal from the High Rise Area will follow, after which we will sail the coastline to Nikki Beach, a gorgeous stretch of sand not far from Oranjestad. The venue for this immersion into the local cuisine and mixology will be the family-owned café Taste My Aruba. It occupies an old house known as a cunucu, the word for "country" in the Papiamentu language spoken in the Dutch Caribbean. During the mixology portion of the class, you will learn to mix two cocktails step by step using locally sourced seasonal ingredients. One of them might be an Aloe Martina utilising the island's main crops - Aloe Vera. The bartending will be a lively social experience much like the cooking class, reflecting the island's culinary heritage.	Participants must be at least 18 years of age. After a briefing and trial run to make sure that you are comfortable on the EZ Raider, you will ride off caravan-style behind the guide. Being emission-free, the vehicles have minimal impact on the island's delicate ecosystems. You can expect an exhilarating ride, especially once you head off-road and into the sand dunes, where you will find the ruins of the Bushiribana Gold Mill, which opened during Aruba's gold rush in the mid-19th century. The majority of the attractions will be natural, including a dramatic cave pool along the shore and a limestone bridge that the pounding surf has carved out of the coastal rocks. The guide will elaborate on the sights and their history during stops at the most scenic places.	This tour is not recommended for guest with limited mobility. Minimum age to participate is 18 years. Oranjestad	Aruba	AUA-019	Highlights	ARUBA HORSEBACK TRAILS	\$249	2.5	MODERATE	Ride horseback through the wilds of Aruba and along the coast for an up-close look at the island's natural beauty. After being paired with a horse suited to your riding abilities, you will proceed from the stables at Gold Mine Ranch along a winding trail through the sand dunes and arid cactus-dotted countryside. You will ride through an area where gold was discovered nearly two centuries ago. Along the way, you will see remnants of the resulting gold rush at places such as the windswept ruins of the Bushiribana Gold Mill, which operated until 1914. The guide will describe how this part of Aruba was settled, its cultural significance and the natural features of the desert-like terrain. The highlight will likely be the exhilarating ride along the secluded beach as the waves crash along the shore. Few experiences are quite so pleasurable, especially with a cool breeze blowing off the ocean.	Participants must be at least 10 years of age, weigh no more than 230 lbs. and have a max height of 6 ft. 2 inches. This tour is not recommended for guests that have problems with neck, back and/or hip, or limited mobility. Recommended long pants, closed toe shoes.

St. Thomas	US Virgin Islands	STT-001	Active	KAYAK, HIKE AND SNORKEL ON CAS CAY	\$139	4	STRENUOUS	Kayak and snorkel through the crystal-clear waters surrounding Cas Cay and then hike around the uninhabited, boomerang-shaped island, which lies within the St. Thomas Mangrove Wildlife Refuge and Marine Sanctuary. Your two-person kayak will be easy to paddle, allowing you to concentrate on the scenery, which is extraordinary. Red mangrove trees grow right to the water's edge, and chances are you will spot all sorts of water birds in the intertwined aboveground roots. The guide will describe how the mangroves filter sediments, stabilise the shorelines and provide a nesting and breeding habitat for fish and sea turtles. You will see much of this marine life while snorkelling just off Cas Cay, where starfish, pufferfish and stingrays are abundant. Afterwards, you can explore the island on foot by following the trails inland and around the coast. The tidal pools are particularly well worth a look, as different marine creatures inhabit them.	This tour is only recommended for active guests in good physical condition. This tour is not recommended for guests with limited mobility or guests who utilise a wheelchair. Gatorade, water, snacks, snorkelling and safety gear, and a dry bag are included. Paddling and snorkelling instructions are also provided; no experience is necessary to participate. St. Thomas	US Virgin Islands	STT-003	Active	CERTIFIED SCUBA REEF AND WRECK DIVING	\$189	4.5	STRENUOUS	Scuba dive in the crystal-clear waters off St. Thomas at a site chosen the day of the excursion to ensure the best conditions. Following a brief orientation on what to expect, you will embark the dive boat and head out to sea. The captain will select a dive site with the best visibility and least current. The water depths typically range from 35-60 feet in the preferred dive sites, which include the Buck Island Wildlife Refuge, a number of Navy barges sunk after World War II and the wreck of the Cartanser Senior. The latter is a 190-foot freighter that sank in 1979 and rests in three pieces that have become artificial reefs teeming with marine life. A PADI-certified dive master and several guides will accompany you throughout the tour and provide assistance if needed.	Participants must sign a waiver, present their dive certification cards and show proof that they have dived in the last two years. Otherwise, interested guests should take a refresher course before the cruise. Diving shouldn't be attempted within 12 hours of flying. Wet suits can be rented. Junior certified divers must be at least 12 years old and accompanied by a parent or guardian. This tour is not recommended for guests with limited mobility or guests who utilise a wheelchair. This upscale sail and snorkel tours starts with a scenic one hour motor-sail out to Buck Island, a fish and birdlife private island sanctuary. Your attentive crew will point out island highlights, serve you sodas, water and advise you about your snorkelling adventure. You'll visit two different snorkel areas- Shipwreck and Turtle Bay- both located on Buck Island, conditions permitting. You will have ample time at each of these different snorkel sites to explore. After receiving your modern snorkel gear, safety vest and snorkel instruction, your crew will lead a guided tour through this underwater haven of abundant marine life, coral formations and colourful sea-life.
